

Hwy 8 Drainage Repair begins in August 2018

Wyoming, Forest Lake, Chisago City

A six-mile section of Hwy 8 from Hwy 61 in Forest Lake and just north of 275th Street in Chisago City will undergo drainage repairs this summer. Project crews will repair or replace several drainage structures. The work will also involve roadside safety work including guardrail upgrades, slope flattening at driveways and connecting roads.

The work is expected to be completed in August and September. **Crews will need to close Hwy 8 between Hazel Ave and Pioneer Rd/Green Lake Trail/County Road 23 sometime in August or September for one week to complete the work.** During the closure, all traffic will be directed to follow the posted detours (**See map on reverse side**). Local access to businesses and homes within the project area will be maintained.

An additional drainage repair project just south of Taylors Falls will occur in September. This work will also require Hwy 8 to be closed and detoured for about a week. For more information, visit the project website and sign up for email updates at:

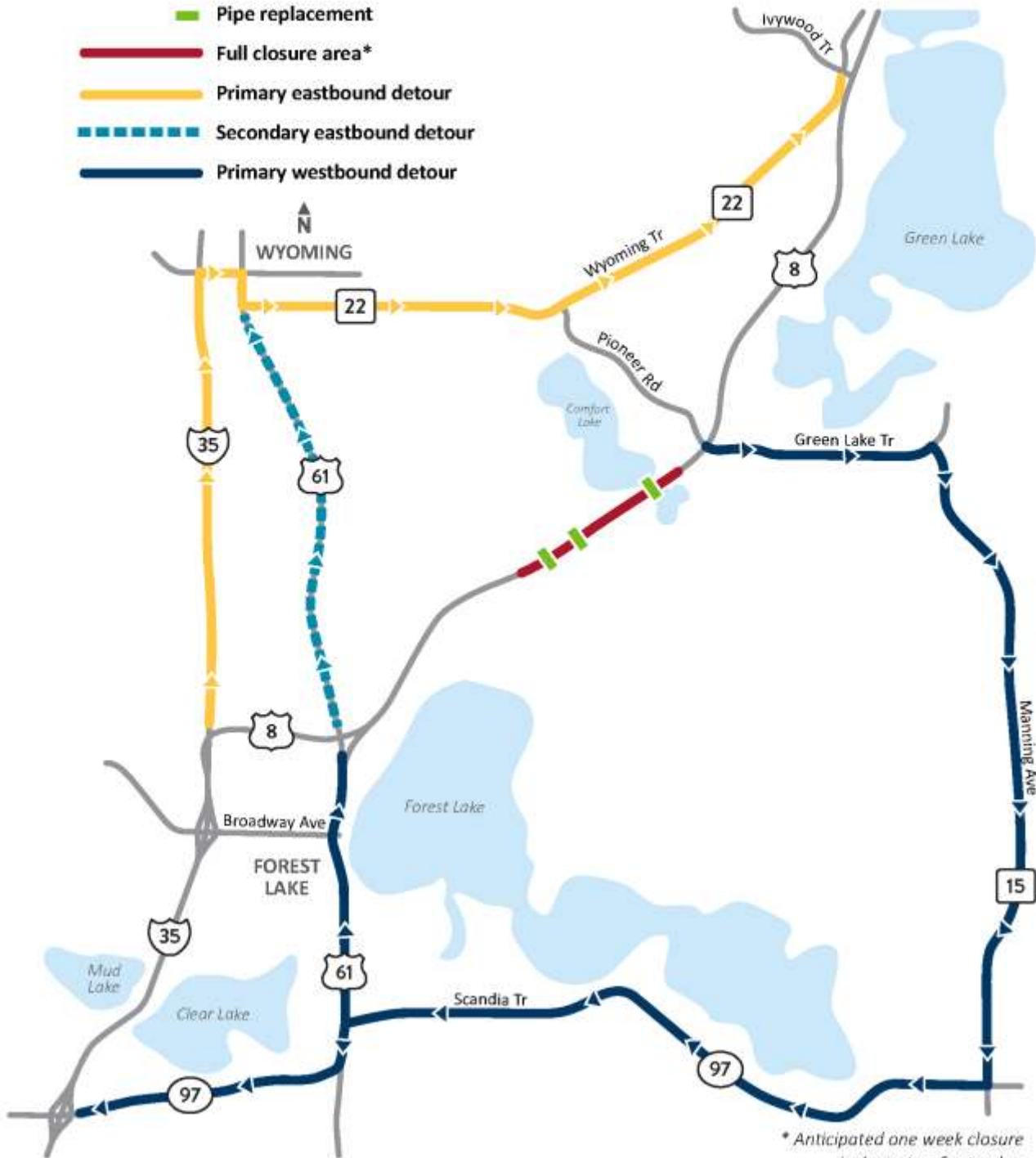
